Three purple candles remind us of loyalty and penance. One pink candle reminds us of love and joy. It is during the 3rd week.

Green boughs remind us of hope and life everlasting.

Candle light reminds us of Jesus, the light of the world.




CHRISTMAS SHOPPING DAY

CURLING


